

FEATURES

MARC Coil Cleaner is specially formulated to penetrate dirt, lint and matted material on condenser coils and fins. Upon contact with the surface of the coil, the foaming action flushes the soil to the surface. Dirt and lint wash away with condensate, leaving the unit cleaned and deodorized in one easy step. If used regularly, MARC Coil Cleaner will keep fins and coils clean and deodorized. Excellent for use on refrigeration and freezer coils, residential and commercial air conditioning units and R/V and automobile A/C units. For use in hotels, motels, factories, schools, hospitals, office buildings, air conditioner services and auto repair services.

DIRECTIONS

Turn fan OFF. Shake can well prior to using. Scrape off matted or loose material with brush.

Hold can 12 inches from air intake side of coils. Spray between fins to allow product to penetrate inner surfaces. Allow to stand 5 minutes. Turn fan on.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

CAUTION

Keep out of reach of children. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
