DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Be sure the area to be patched is clean of dirt, debris and loose material, and is dry. Spray **MARC Asphalt Softener** over the entire area to thoroughly wet the surface. Do not over wet to the point of puddling. Immediately fill the area with the asphalt patching compound, and tamp in place.
