DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Because of the various types and sizes of waste water treatment systems, the following are only suggested amounts.

MARC FOG Eliminator can be added to the lift station by first making a slurry in warm water. Use within 30 minutes. This product may be applied several manholes before the lift station to allow for adequate contact time.

Add 1 to 2 pounds of **MARC FOG Eliminator** per 1,000 gallons of sewage flow in lift stations, depending on the severity of the problem. For best results, add during period of lowest flow to enable the longest contact time.

CAUTION: May irritate eyes and skin. Avoid eye and skin contact. Wear rubber gloves and safety glasses when handling. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not take internally. If in eyes, flush thoroughly with water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If on skin, wash off with soap and water. If swallowed, contact a physician. If inhaled, get fresh air.
