<u>SEE THRU</u>	<u>WATER</u>	<u>FREEZING POINT</u>
2 Parts	1 Part	-17°F
1 Part	1 Part	0°F
1 Part	2 Parts	+ 15°F

Turn on defrosters when windshield washers are operating during freezing temperatures.

SPRING AND SUMMER—
