MARC Return Line Treatment is a volatile neutralizing agent for corrosion protection in steam and condensate return lines. It is specially formulated to transfer out of the boiler with the steam produced. This will protect lines, traps, tanks, and pumps against rust, corrosion and pitting.

MARC Return Line Treatment raises the pH to neutralize acidic condensate, and reduces copper and iron content of condensate, thereby helping to minimize boiler deposits.

Regular use of **MARC Return Line Treatment** will help keep equipment operating at full capacity, and will save on expensive repair and replacement.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

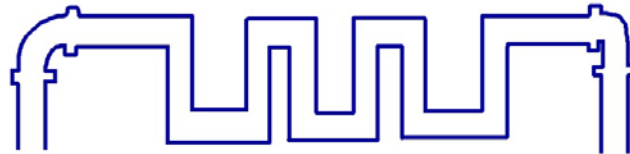
Dosage of **MARC Return Line Treatment** will vary depending on amount of steam produced and corrosive gases present. The correct dose can be determined by monitoring the pH of the condensate. Initially add 1 to 2 quarts per 1,000 gallons of boiler capacity. As a maintenance dose, add a sufficient **MARC Return Line Treatment** to raise and keep the pH of the condensate water at approximately 8.
