

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Add a sufficient amount of **MARC Grease Trap Conditioner** to provide at least a one inch layer of product on the surface of the grease trap. Sixteen fluid ounces (1 pint) will initially treat 32 square inches of surface area. Pour **MARC Grease Trap Conditioner** into drain nearest the grease trap, or add directly to the trap. Add one pint per week thereafter. Large grease traps and those subject to heavy loads of grease, fats and oils will require larger and more frequent additions of **MARC Grease Trap Conditioner**. If grease trap has a large build-up, clean out manually before adding product. Regular use of **MARC Grease Trap Conditioner** will normally eliminate manual cleaning.

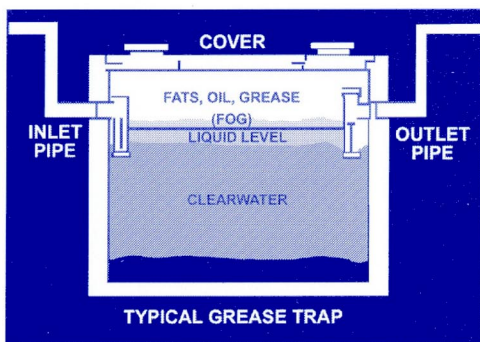
