DESCRIPTION:

MARC Black Ice is a concentrated formula that encapsulates airborne odors and neutralizes the most offensive odor problems. A single spray of this powerful concentrate converts odors into a pleasant scent. MARC Black Ice continues to destroy odors for up to 24 hours. It penetrates even those hard-to-reach areas and provides a large, neutralized zone.

DIRECTIONS:

As a space spray: Insert pump spray attachment and tighten. Spray towards center of room. Only a light spray is needed in most cases.

As a contact spray: Spray directly at source of odors. Do not spray directly on tile floors or fabrics as slipperiness or staining may occur.

As an evaporative deodorizer: May be put into vaporizers and humidifiers. Spray into water very sparingly.

Signal Word: DANGER

Contains: C9-C12 Isoalkanes



Hazard Statements: Combustible liquid. May be fatal if swallowed and enters airways.

Precautionary Statements: Keep away from heat/sparks/open flames/hot surfaces. - No smoking. Wash face, hands and any exposed skin thoroughly after handling. Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep Cool. Store locked up. Dispose of contents/container to a approved waste disposal plant. In case of

fire: Use dry sand, dry chemical or alcohol-resistant foam for extinction.

FIRST AID: If Swallowed: Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician. Do NOT induce vomiting. **If In Eyes:** Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes.

Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing. **If Inhaled:** If breathing is difficult, remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. **If On Skin (or hair):** Remove/Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower.
