Description: MARC Sandscreen Discs are used for removal or repair of coatings on wood floor surfaces. Sandscreen discs are also used in the final stages of floor sanding to smooth raised grain. These discs are available in standard round styles for conventional floor machines and rectangular discs designed for oscillating machines.

Use: MARC Sandscreen Discs are used for removal or repair of coatings on wood floor surfaces, especially refinishing gym floors. Use both sides of the disc. They may be used either wet or dry. Use a screen driver pad to prevent screen slippage and to maximize performance. They may be used with conventional or oscillating floor machines.

Construction: MARC Sandscreen Discs are constructed with water-proof resins and silicon carbide abrasives on both sides of the discs. Open mesh construction resists loading.
